Official Program Rules (“Official Rules”)

PROGRAM ADMINISTERED BY INTERIOR DESIGNERS OF CANADA (“IDC”).

PROGRAM BEGINS ON MARCH 18, 2019 AT 9:01 A.M. ET AND ENDS ON SEPTEMBER 13, 2019 AT 11:59 P.M. ET (“PROGRAM PERIOD”).

By participating, entrants agree to be bound by these Official Rules and the decisions of IDC, which are binding and final, without right of appeal, on all matters relating to this Program. Program is subject to all applicable federal, provincial, territorial and local laws.

PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY: Open to legal residents of Canada. To qualify for this award, a participant must submit their application within the posted deadline and be an IDC member by the submission deadline on MAY 17, 2019. The number of IDC members selected for the Emerging Leader Award will be dependant on the number and quality of applicants. Those selected will get a two-day, all-expense-paid trip to the IDC design symposium in Vancouver on September 12 and 13, 2019.

ENTRANTS: IDC members with less than ten years of experience in the interior design industry.

AWARD: The award includes two nights’ accommodation at the Grand Hyatt Regency Hotel in Vancouver, B.C.; economy transportation (depending on proximity to conference location) by either plane or train; meals; and program activities. The award does not include travel insurance, transfers, personal expenditure and incidental costs other than those stated. All travel is in accordance with IDC’s Board-approved travel policy. It is the responsibility of the award winner to ensure they have valid government-issued identification and travel insurance and obtain any necessary vaccinations and visas for their trip. The award is subject to availability, non transferable and there are no cash alternatives.

HOW TO PARTICIPATE: A jury comprised of professionals in the industry and design community, and IDC representatives will review all valid entries from May 17 to July 1, 2019.

AWARD NOTIFICATION: Winners of IDC’s Emerging Leader’ Award will be notified by mail, telephone or email at IDC’s discretion by July 1, 2019. If individuals are identified and notified that they may be an eligible award nominee, they must respond to the notification and provide complete contact information (full name, email address and mailing address) for booking purposes within two (2) business days. In addition, award nominees will be asked to provide an active credit card number that will be placed in a hold for a maximum of \$100 that will only be charged if entrants fail to meet conference participation requirements. The award will be forfeited if it goes unclaimed by this time.

USE OF INFORMATION/PRIVACY: Each entrant grants permission for IDC and its designees to use his/her name, address (city and province/territory), photograph, voice and/or other likeness for advertising, trade and promotional purposes in any and all media now known or hereafter discovered, worldwide, in perpetuity, without compensation, notification or permission. Each entrant consents to the collection, use and disclosure of his/her personal information for the purposes of this program and grants permission for IDC to disclose personal information to its related and affiliated companies, contractors and agents to assist in the program.

GENERAL CONDITIONS: This program is subject to all applicable federal, provincial, and local laws and regulations. All entrants agree to be bound by these Official Rules. IDC, in its sole discretion, reserves the right to disqualify any person it finds to be in violation of these rules or tampering with or otherwise abusing any aspect of the program.
