

## Approval of Bylaw Amendment

The current IDC bylaws, which were approved by membership in 2017, do not include the Alberta Association of Architects and Architects & Licenced Interior Designers (“AAA, LID”) as part of Provincial Interior Design Associations under sec. 1.01 Definitions.

### 1.01 Definitions

- a) **“Provincial Interior Design Association”** means one of the following:
- Interior Designers Institute of British Columbia (“IDIBC”);
  - Interior Designers of Alberta (Registered Interior Designers Institute of Alberta) (“IDA”); & the Alberta Association of Architects, Architects & Licenced Interior Designers (“AAA, LID”)
  - Interior Designers Association of Saskatchewan (“IDAS”);
  - Professional Interior Designers Institute of Manitoba (“PIDIM”);
  - Association of Registered Interior Designers of Ontario (“ARIDO”);
  - Association Professionnelle Des Designers D'intérieur Du Québec (“APDIQ”);
  - Association of Interior Designers of New Brunswick (AIDNB);
  - Interior Designers of Nova Scotia (“IDNS”); and
  - Interior Designers of Newfoundland and Labrador (“IDNL”).

Including these associations under the Definitions, under the Provincial Interior Design Association is for housekeeping purposes and will align with CIDQ acceptance.
